About This Tour

Toto Tours is becoming known for its annual Gay Pride tours in different parts of the world. We get the party started in Brussels, Belgium, a multicultural hub of the European Union with one of the continent's liveliest and friendliest LGBT scenes. We work our way through the dazzling historic cities of Bruges, Ghent and Antwerp before reaching Amsterdam for the final four nights of the tour.

It's hard to imagine a more gay and lesbian friendly travel destination than Amsterdam. In 2001, the Netherlands became the first country in the world to officially recognize same-sex marriages. Other countries like Belgium, South Africa, Argentina and most Scandinavian countries followed shortly after. The annual Gay Pride celebration boasts the world's only pride parade on water. The cavalcade of colorful canal boats packed with hundreds of extravagantly costumed gays is like nothing you've ever seen. Don't miss our best Pride tour to date!

ITINERARY

Saturday, July 27, 2019

Arrive in Belgium

Your international flight should land in Brussels, Belgium (airport code BRU) by mid-afternoon today. Collect your luggage, exit the terminal and take a taxi to the city center and our hotel. Our group will gather for the first time in early evening to have a cocktail in the hotel lobby, before taking a short walk to a nearby restaurant for our Welcome Dinner. Overnight in Brussels. (*Dinner included*)

Sunday, July 28, 2019

Brussels Sightseeing

Enjoy a half-day sightseeing tour of Brussels, known for its breathtaking medieval center and Parisian-style wide boulevards, and also for its bustling 21st-century modern city center. Sights will include the Gothic Cathedral St. Michel, the Palace of Justice (reputed to be the largest structure built in the 19th century), the ornate Royal Palace, and Grand-Place, one of the most beautiful squares in all of Europe. The square is dominated by the 15th century Flamboyant Town Hall, the Neo-Gothic Breadhouse and the Baroque guildhalls of the Guilds of Brussels. Overnight in Brussels. (*Breakfast*)

Monday, July 29, 2019

Ghent / Bruges

This morning, we make the 35-mile, hour-long journey to the town of Ghent. Enjoy a panoramic overview tour of the city, known for its glorious medieval buildings, with a stop for lunch in the center of town. We drive another hour (30 miles) and arrive in the city of Bruges by mid-afternoon. Along with other canal-based European cities, Bruges is often called "Venice of the North" for its close connection to the waterways that run throughout the city center. Upon checking in at our hotel, the rest of the day is free. Overnight in Bruges. (Breakfast / Lunch)

Tuesday, July 30, 2019

Bruges Sightseeing

This morning enjoy a walking tour of Bruges' medieval center. Bruges is filled with historic monuments and fantastic Flemish architecture dating back to the 14th century. It is such a significant place that the entire city center was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2010. In terms of sheer beauty, Bruges has few rivals. The afternoon and evening are free to explore the city on your own. A great way to see some of the hidden, out-of-the-way spots is on an optional cruise along the city canals. You might also want to climb the Beffroi Tower for a birds-eye view of the city. Overnight in Bruges. (Breakfast)

Wednesday, July 31, 2019

Antwerp / Amsterdam

After breakfast, we check out of our hotel and make the 90-minute drive from Bruges to the city of Antwerp, known for its diamond trade. The city is home to an array of 16th and 17th century architectural marvels. We take a walking tour of Antwerp's town center with a break for lunch. We continue driving north for another 2 hours, crossing into The Netherlands and arriving in Amsterdam in late afternoon. After checking in to our hotel, the evening is free to explore the surrounding area of our hotel and enjoy the delights of this vibrant city, which is our home for the final four nights of the tour. Dinner is included at our hotel tonight. (All Meals)

Thursday, August 1, 2019

Amsterdam Sightseeing

This morning, embark on a half-day sightseeing tour of Amsterdam, getting an overview of the city and its main attractions. We will visit the National Monument, the Royal Palace of the Netherlands, and the three concentric canals known as Grachtengordel (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). Dam Square, with its notable buildings, lies in the historical center of Amsterdam. The name derives from the square's original function: as a dam on the Amstel River (hence also the name of the city). Today it is a popular gathering place for locals and visitors. After a stop for a nice three-course lunch, we have tickets to tour the world-famous Rijksmuseum, with its large collection of masterpieces by Rembrandt and Vermeer. Overnight in Amsterdam. (*Breakfast / Lunch*)

Friday, August 2, 2019

Canal Cruise / Farewell Dinner

Enjoy a free morning to sleep in late or do some leisurely strolling near our hotel. This afternoon, we take a canal cruise, which is a lovely relaxed way to see much of historic Amsterdam from the waterways which ring the city. The rest of the day is at your leisure, and you may want to take an optional tour of the Anne Frank House or visit some of the city's many museums. This evening, Toto Tours hosts an early Farewell Dinner, so we can keep tomorrow's Gay Pride celebration completely free. Overnight in Amsterdam. (Breakfast / Dinner)

Gay Pride Canal Parade

Amsterdam Pride happens every August, attracting several hundred-thousand visitors. It is one of the largest publicly held events in The Netherlands each year. Almost a week of activities for the LGBTQ community culminates in the Canal Parade, a procession of many different decoration-festooned boats filled with costumed revelers, that floats through the center of the city. Our group will scout out a prime viewing spot, and the entire day is free to participate in the merriment. Overnight in Amsterdam. (Breakfast)

TOUR PREPARATION

Entry Requirements - For U.S. Citizens a valid passport is the only document required to enter Belgium and The Netherlands for stays of up to 60 days.

Immunizations & Health-- No immunizations are currently required for travel to Belgium and The Netherlands, but it is wise to have your inoculations up-to-date. Is your tetanus booster current?

Exit Requirements - There is currently no separate departure tax required of visitors leaving Amsterdam other than that included with the cost of your airline ticket.

Making Travel Arrangements to Belgium

On this tour, international airfare is NOT included. You will need to get your international air to Brussels, Belgium (BRU), and returning from Amsterdam, The Netherlands (AMS), back to the U.S.A. We encourage you to work with Steven Goldberg at Frosch Travel in Chicago, who knows the best flights to get you there and back again.

Please arrive in Brussels by mid-afternoon on Saturday, July 27, 2019.

Departure is from Amsterdam, The Netherlands on Sunday, August 4, 2019.

When calling, please identify yourself as a Toto Tours participant. If you leave a message on Steven's voice mail, he will return your call promptly. He will be happy to discuss your travel plans and help you decide when to purchase your ticket for the best rate.

NOTE: The recent trend in travel is for travelers to finalize their plans much closer to departure time than was customary in the past. While we try to be as flexible as possible we often must turn away last minute registrants because we relinquish hotel space and air reservations 8 – 12 weeks prior to departure! Please keep this in mind when making your travel plans.

WHAT TO BRING

In July and August, average daily temperatures in Belgium and The Netherlands range from 55 to 72 degrees. You won't need a suit jacket or tie, as the tour is informal and dinner attire will be casual. Try to pack light and bring only one piece of luggage plus your carry-on. Create mix and match outfits, and think about layering! Pack any medications you require in a carry-on bag and leave expensive jewelry at home.

Suggested Packing List:

- · Proof of citizenship. Passport required.
- · Nice casual wear for dinners.
- Long pants (2 3 pairs), belt.
- Long-sleeve shirts (3 4).
- · Socks, underwear for 8 days.
- · Sweater or fleece for cool evenings.
- · Personal toiletries.
- · Camera, lots of digital memory, extra batteries.
- Ziploc Bags (sandwich size for documents, gallon size for wet items or toiletries).
- Electrical Adapter. The electricity supply in Belgium is 230 Volts/50 Hertz. Sockets are type E, requiring two round plugs, which can be used in both C and F sockets. In Amsterdam, the current is the same at 230 Volts/50 Hertz, but they use the C and F sockets. Click here to see examples and obtain more information.

Money Matters

The Euro is the national currency of both Belgium and The Netherlands (the code is EUR when looking up exchange rates). American Express, Diners Club, MasterCard and Visa are accepted in larger establishments. click here to see the current exchange rate.

Tipping: In restaurants the law requires menu prices to include service charge, and tipping is a matter of personal choice. Most people leave some small change if they're satisfied and 5% is usually plenty. It's common to leave small change at tables in bars and cafés. We will present collective tips to guides and drivers at appropriate times throughout the tour.

Tour prices per person

Price: \$3,600 in double occupancy hotel accommodations.

Private Room: \$1,000 additional, for a total tour price of \$4,600. (Paying a single supplement is not required. If this is not possible, a single supplement will be applied to your reservation before the final payment date.)

Deposit: \$600. (Due at time of registration for the tour. May be paid with a credit card.)

Remaining Balance (main tour): \$3,000 double / \$4,000 single

Remaining Balance Due: May 8, 2019 (80 days prior to departure) (Full payment required with reservation form if enrolling after this date.)

Note: The tour price does not include bank service charges for processing credit card payments, and assumes that the balance of the tour price will be paid by check. If you would like to pay the final balance with a credit card, a 4% service charge will be applied. Let us know if you wish to pay by credit card, and we will adjust your invoice accordingly.
